BAC Resolution Recommending Approval of the Shortlist of Consultants for the Procurement of Consulting Services to undertake the Project Management of the construction of the new DOST- Food and Nutrition Research Institute (DOST-FNRI) building (Phase 2) - with redesigning works of the existing Detailed Architectural and Engineering Design (DAED)

WHEREAS, the Food and Nutrition Research Institute (FNRI) advertised the Request for Expression of Interest (REOI) for the **Procurement of Consulting Services to undertake the Project Management of the construction of the new DOST- Food and Nutrition Research Institute (DOST-FNRI) building (Phase 2) - with redesigning works of the existing Detailed Architectural and Engineering Design (DAED)**, by posting in the PhilGEPS, FNRI website and in the different conspicuous places within the DOST System and the FNRI premises for seven (7) calendar days;

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisements, two (2) bidders submitted Applications for Eligibility and Shortlisting documents;

WHEREAS, during the opening of eligibility requirements on April 11, 2025, one (1) bidders passed the preliminary examination of the Bids by the FNRI BAC – TWG;

WHEREAS, upon careful examination, validation and verification of the consultant's submitted Applications for Eligibility and Shortlisting documents, the following are the average score of as per attached evaluation and recommendation by the DOST-FNRI BAC Technical Working Group for Infrastructure;

WHEREAS, the minimum passing score to qualify in the shortlist shall be 65%:

NOW THEREFORE, in the light of the foregoing considerations, We the members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby resolve as it is hereby resolved:

- a. To recommend **Enrique O. Olonan and Associates, Co. and P-Square Associates, Co.** as eligible to proceed in the subsequent phase of the bidding process by obtaining an average score higher than the minimum passing score of 65%; and



- b. To recommend for the approval by the Deputy Director and Officer-in-Charge, Office of the Director of the Food and Nutrition Research Institute the foregoing findings.
