



ANNOUNCEMENT OF VACANCY

The Food and Nutrition Research Institute (FNRI) is the Department of Science and Technology's principal research arm on food and nutrition. It is mandated to undertake researches that define the citizenry's nutritional status, with reference to the malnutrition problem, its causes and effects, develop and recommend policy options, strategies, programs and projects for implementation by appropriate agencies, diffuse knowledge and technologies in food and nutrition and provide S&T services to relevant stakeholders (as per E.O. 366, November 13, 2009). Its mission is to provide accurate data, correct information, and innovative technologies to fight malnutrition.

Brief functions of the position:

- Determines, and sets forward the Institute's strategic R & D and S & T plans, objectives, and policies related to food and nutrition researches, as well as science and technology innovations;
- Develops and implements research proposals, guides, and directs the implementation of R&D and S&T activities, and performs oversight functions in monitoring and evaluating proposals;
- Renders advisory function as an expert on matters related to food and nutrition to various international and local partners and collaborators;
- Assumes full command and responsibilities over the properties, assets, financial, and human resources of the Institute;
- Ensures that research results are translated to policies, guidelines, or laws; and are disseminated to relevant stakeholders;
- Leads the Institute in creating fresh networks, establish partnerships and collaborations with the private sector or other government agencies in food and nutrition research and development needs;
- Represents the Institute and the Philippine government in various meetings, conferences, and seminars in local and international settings; and
- Performs ad hoc tasks assigned by the Office of the Undersecretary for R&D and the DOST Secretary.

CSC Minimum Qualifications:

Education	:	Bachelor's degree
Experience	:	3 years of supervisory experience
Training	:	None required
Eligibility	:	Career Service Executive Eligibility (CSEE)/Career Executive Service (CES). In the absence of CES or CSEE eligibility, the candidate must apply for eligibility within one year from assumption to duty

Preferred Qualifications:

- Education : Graduate degree in any basic or applied science or engineering, **preferably with a Doctorate degree.**
- Training : Preferably with Technical, managerial and leadership trainings
- Experience :
 1. At least eight (8) years of relevant experience in food and nutrition research, 4 years of which must have shown very satisfactory research leadership performance and S&T capability.
 2. Must have implemented at least 2 internationally-funded and 2 locally-funded researches.
 3. With supervisory experience in an organization/ institution engaged in research and development in food, nutrition or allied fields; with at least 50 personnel under direct supervision.

Compensation Package:

Monthly salary at SG 28-1; Mandatory allowances such as but not limited to: Representation and Transportation Allowance, Personal Economic Relief Allowance, Year-End Bonus, Cash Gift, Uniform Allowance; Other allowable that may be provided by law such as those under the Magna Carta for Scientists, Engineers, Researchers and other S&T Personnel in Government (RA 8439).

12. Other relevant documents supporting claims on relevant education, trainings and accomplishments and performance rating/s if applicable.

APPLICANTS WITH INCOMPLETE DOCUMENTS SHALL NOT BE ENTERTAINED.

1. Medical Certificate
2. Psychological Examination (to be arranged by DOST-FNRI)
3. Statement of Mission and Vision, and Plans for FNRI
4. NBI Clearance
5. For Government Employees: Clearances from CSC, Sandiganbayan, and the Office of the Ombudsman.

Shortlisted applicants must be willing to be subjected to a background investigation (BI) if need arises.
